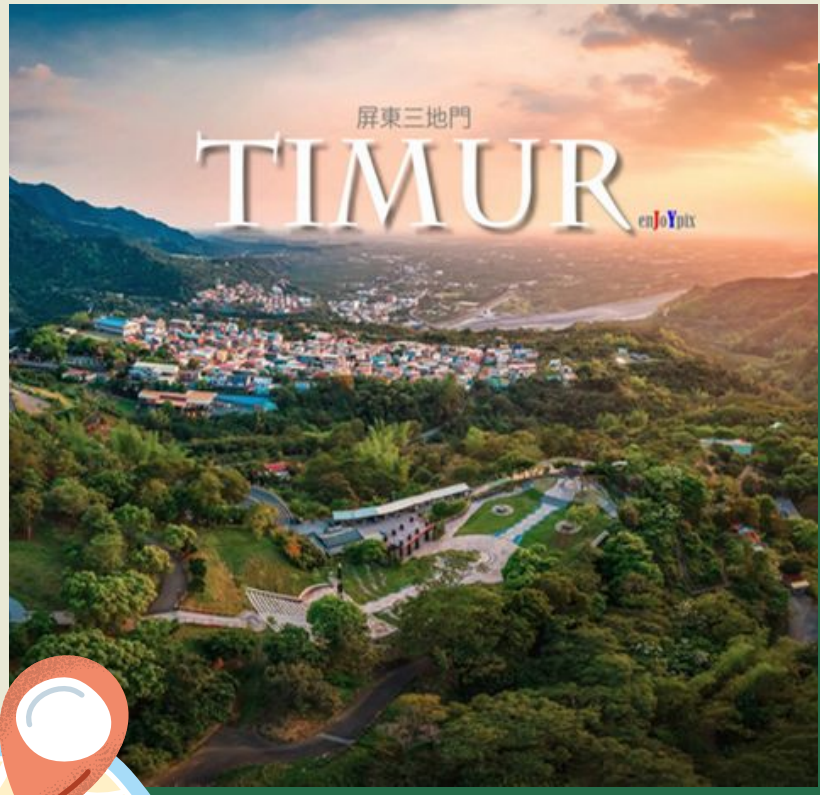


My Favorite Place in Pingtung
