

Must-Visit Attractions in Pingtung

01 Kenting National Park

Kenting National Park, located on the Hengchun Peninsula at the southern tip of Taiwan, is the country's first national park. It is famous for its tropical coastal scenery and coral reefs. Popular spots include Nanwan for water activities, Baisha Bay for beautiful sunsets, and Longpan Grassland for wide sea views. The Eluanbi Lighthouse is also a well-known landmark.
