This is not just a pretty spot for Instagrammers; it was once the quarters for Japanese flight officers and later became a military dependents' village for the Nationalist army. It was named "Star Village" because many generals came from here.

Today, it is the largest cluster of Japanese-style buildings in Taiwan, boasting over 60 old Japanese houses. It houses independent bookstores, specialty restaurants, and qipao (cheongsam) experiences, and is one of the best-preserved Japanese-style building complexes in Taiwan.
